

➤ Personal System of Instruction

The Accelerated Christian Education (A.C.E.) system is based on the well-researched methodology of a Personalised System of Instruction (PSI) (Keller 1968). This system creates opportunity for a learner to work in an individualised self-paced manner that embraces discovery learning and content mastery.

What do we mean by mastery? Mastery refers to a student's ability to consistently achieve high marks within relatively small units of content. They may not progress onto the next unit until they have achieved mastery but are always allowed the time required to do so. This results in motivated students taking ownership over their own progress.

A Unique Approach to Education

The A.C.E. learning framework places the learner firmly at the heart of the learning process and they take charge and full responsibility for their own learning. This is a self-instructional system where the learner becomes the responsible person. The unique methodology teaches learners to take responsibility for their own academic progress, including working through the material, called PACEs, completing activities properly, scoring correctly, and preparing for assessments.

This methodology makes it possible for learners to gain confidence while working on their own and become self-disciplined in completing what is required. The educator or parent is still on hand to assist the student when they struggle to understand a concept, but their role is now more to facilitate learning to take place by the student themselves and to inspire the student to achieve their goals.



How Does A.C.E. Work?


A.C.E. diverges from the use of conventional textbooks and provides curriculum materials in relatively small units of content called PACEs. Each PACE includes self-instructional lessons and achievable activities. Each grade generally consists of 12 PACEs in each subject. The learner begins a PACE by noting the goals and the concepts he/she will be required to learn. This ensures that from the beginning of each PACE, the learner knows what is expected, and assumes responsibility for his/her own learning.

A final PACE Test measures comprehension and ensures that students fully understand one PACE before progressing onto the next.

The A.C.E. system makes it possible for any learner, the high achiever or the one with specific needs, to master subject matter.

From preschool to Grade 12, each learner is taught:

- to set goals and meet deadlines.
- to develop critical-thinking skills.
- to think creatively and independently.
- to take responsibility for learning.





Benefits of Using A.C.E.

- Support Structure

It is important for homeschooled children to register with a Home Education Academy. Character traits like honesty, kindness, and loyalty are taught within the curriculum materials. The learner can observe Godly living in the Christian character illustrations and then apply the lessons to his/her own life. This personal development component is inherent to the programme and is designed to positively impact learners and nurture socially accountable young people. With A.C.E., learners do not only learn how to make a living, but also how to live!

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Diagnostic Testing

Learners making the transition from a traditional school to homeschooling benefit from the A.C.E. diagnostic testing system. The reality is that a conventional grade promotion does not necessarily indicate that work has been mastered. Often, the sequence/order of content of the curriculum is literally not the same as that of a previous school/programme, which results in gaps in the learner's progress.

Therefore, academic material is prescribed on a basis of diagnosed levels of academic achievement, and not on the basis of the grade level the learner was promoted to or on the basis of age.

Diagnostic placement testing ensures that students begin at the exact point of their academic needs, for each subject. Diagnostic testing determines if there are any "learning gaps" that first need attention before dealing with new concepts.

Children from Grade 2 and up who are not yet on the A.C.E. programme are required to write diagnostic tests before starting any academic work. Home Education Academies have a set of hard-copy tests for parents to purchase, which are then done at the child's home or at the academy. Alternatively, students may write the tests online. The hard-copy tests are advisable, as these have been adapted to the South African curriculum.

- Qualifications

Users of the A.C.E. programme have the choice of the following three exit qualification options to pursue in the high school levels:

- 1) The international A.C.E. qualification, accredited by Lighthouse Christian Academy.
- 2) The National Senior Certificate via the Independent Examination Board (IEB).
- 3) The General Education Diploma from the USA.




Register Your Homeschool
